AIGA, the professional association for design, provides scholarships to underrepresented and economically disadvantaged students who are studying design and arts disciplines in colleges and universities in the United States. **Our primary aims are to increase diversity in the creative professions and to foster social and environmental responsibility in the artists, designers, companies, and studios of tomorrow.** Scholarship recipients are selected not only for their talent and need, but also for their demonstrated commitment to give back to the community through their work.

A jury of creative professionals appointed by AIGA annually evaluates applications. In making selections, jurors consider and prioritize quality of submitted work, financial need, underrepresented and BIPOC students, academic record, recommendations, and strength of written purpose statements.

Since 1995, \$1.3 million dollars has been awarded to more than 800 college students!

Scholarships start at \$2,500 and reach \$5,000 and are disbursed to educational institutions. In addition, honorable mention cash prizes in the amount of \$500 or \$750 may also be awarded directly to students.

Each year, hundreds of students apply for these scholarships, and on average 20 receive awards. **This is a testament to not only the strength of the student work, but also a reminder of the rising costs of education and the ever-growing need for funding to increase access and ensure equitable opportunities for the next generation of creative talent.** Your investment makes a difference in our profession and our communities—**together we can do amazing things.**

WAYS OF GIVING

AIGA Worldstudio Scholarships can be tailored to suit your individual needs, your institution's philanthropic goals, or your corporation's cause-related marketing initiatives. The following are some examples:

\$3,250*

One scholarship awarded in a family name, or in the name of your corporation or institution.

\$6,500 – \$13,000*

Two to four scholarships awarded in your name. Additional amounts can be given at the same time in increments of \$2,500 to be awarded in the same year or designated as multi-year scholarship gifts.

\$30,000 – \$50,000 +

At higher levels of giving, AIGA and Worldstudio can discuss with you options to custom-tailor a program that includes named scholarships as well as mentorships and promotional opportunities. Additional amounts can be given at the same time to be awarded in the same year or designated as multi-year scholarship gifts.

**Includes a \$750 one-time admin fee per one-year named scholarship to administer the scholarship, notify applicants, disburse awards, produce certificates, and promote scholarships.*
